Subject: Mr. Corman current health update

We would like to provide you with a new medical update on Rick. Unfortunately, on July 2nd, 2010, we found some recurrent cancer in Rick's bone by doing a very sensitive PET/CT scan. This occurrence is so small and detected at such an early stage that his oncologist feels we can get him back into remission by doing some radiation and more intense chemotherapy. We are pleased that he will only require four radiation treatments this time compared to the twenty-eight that were needed at his initial treatment and again at the last relapse. We are fortunate that this relapse was caught early and are optimistic that Rick will be back into remission within three to six months.
