We have good news for the latest medical update for Mr. Corman. After completing four cycles of intensive chemotherapy, a PET CT scan shows that the multiple myeloma is again in complete remission! Rick will still continue to receive the chemotherapy for a few more cycles to make the remission last! He will probably finish the chemotherapy at the end of the January 2011. We are happy to report that the intensive therapy has been a success. While his doctor in Boston (Dr. Paul Richardson) and I are very pleased with this outcome, multiple myeloma remains a serious incurable disease. Even after completing the current chemotherapy, Rick will take some maintenance medications and continue to be carefully monitored for recurrence of cancer. We remain hopeful that new therapies will become available to treat any future relapses of the multiple myeloma.
