Partially funded through the National Clean Diesel Funding Assistance Program's Diesel Emissions Reduction Act (DERA) dollars, the RP14BD's ability to reduce diesel fuel use and greenhouse gas emissions up to 45% and nitrogen oxides (NOx) and particulates by 80% - 90% will allow POCCA to improve air quality for the community in which it operates.
