12:30 - 1:30 pm	Historic Downtown Midway (lunch provided to invitees)
2:15 pm	Lexington, Central Kentucky Yard (133 Buchanan St.)

A limited number of public officials and media will be on board the caboose to record this moment in time, while the **R. J. Corman motor coach will be available to take the additional media and special guests** along the route. The public is welcome to observe, from a safe distance, Old Smokey as it travels to R. J. Corman Railroad Company's Central Kentucky Yard on Buchanan Street.
